Confession and Absolution

In keeping with 1 Cor. 11:27-32, we examine ourselves and confess our sin to the lord. The priest proclaims the redemptive work of Christ in the Absolution. On the cross, Jesus bore the weight and consequence of our sin. In His resurrection, He overcame sin and death. Through faith in Him, we are set free from sin and death and are restored to right relationship with the Father.

Passing of the Peace

This is a time to greet one another and ensure peace in the Body of Christ as we come to the Table (Matt. 5:23-24).

Offertory and Doxology

Holy Communion

O Sacred Head, Now Wounded

'Tis So Sweet To Trust In Jesus

The Eucharist, the climax of the service, is a celebration of the redeeming work of Jesus Christ. We come empty-handed to receive the Life only He can offer. All baptized Christians who belong to Jesus in faith are invited to come to the Table.
